The forthcoming public procurement reform

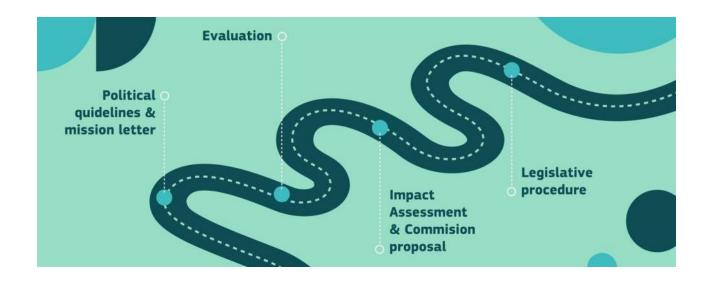




- Efficient public investment: there is a need for consistency of the legal framework, simplification of procedures and a "digital by design" system.
